

LAMBERT FAMILY TRUST SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The CIEF Lambert Family Trust Scholarship was established by Jim Lambert and his family. The purpose of the scholarship is to support students who have a desire to further their education in the construction trades either through entering a formal approved apprenticeship program or through continuing education at any approved construction trade program within the Los Rios College District. Awards will be given in the amount of \$500 per student.

Eligibility:

- Must be accepted into a formal approved apprenticeship program OR through continuing education at any
 approved construction trade program within the Los Rios College District. Construction Management students
 are not eligible for this scholarship.
- Graduating high school senior or currently enrolled in an approved college or apprenticeship program.
- Candidates must have a current cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.

Required Documents:

- Completed and signed Application Form (below).
- Most recent official or unofficial transcript (showing cumulative and most recent grades).
- Paragraph not to exceed 250 words on how you will use the scholarship if awarded.
